

CODE OF CONDUCT

The MaineGeneral's Peter Alfond Prevention and Healthy Living Center is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all participants. Conduct that does not support the MaineGeneral mission or core values is not acceptable.

Be responsible – You are responsible for your behavior. If you have a concern or problem, please contact Alicia Rice at 207-626-7347.

Be caring – No fighting, physical or verbal confrontation is allowed in MaineGeneral programs or facilities. Refrain from abusive or profane language. No yelling, shouting, arguing or raising your voice in a confrontational manner.

Be respectful – All participants must be respectful. Intentional damage to another person's property or MaineGeneral property will not be tolerated. Mistreatment or harassment of staff, patients, volunteers or other participants is strictly prohibited.

Be honest – You are expected to be honest and polite with other participants and staff.

Be healthy – Unsafe or dangerous behavior will not be tolerated. MaineGeneral is a safe zone. Use or possession of drugs, alcohol, or weapons is not allowed in MaineGeneral programs or facilities. No tobacco is allowed in MaineGeneral facilities, or on the premises.

MaineGeneral reserves the right to refuse admittance, participation or to request individuals to leave MaineGeneral programs or facilities at any time. Any fees paid will be refunded.
